






The familiar story of Mary and Martha can be unsettling. Mary can appear to be a bit lazy. She is gladly listening to Jesus but seems to be ignoring her sister, Martha, who is providing Jesus proper hospitality, and important, caring practice in the Bible. This story follows on the heels of the parable of the good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37) where someone took the initiative to act with loving service. These two stories are linked to point out that service to others is important, and that service is best done with the message of Christ in our hearts. Service that is done in faith is not distracted but energized by Jesus' message. It is neither loving service or attention to Jesus but loving service that is motivated by the message of Jesus. It is essential to our lives of faith and love, to listen to Jesus. This results in lives of service that will not be a distraction but will be acts of love through Jesus.

Pray: Loving God, help us to center our lives on your strength and wisdom so that we may serve you as we love others through Jesus Christ. Amen







Why?

My name is Becky Ponto and I have a traumatic brain injury (TBI). It is very hard to understand the life we have from a TBI. We need to find a new life we will live with the TBI. Talking to other people that have a TBI and understand what it is like to have frustration, anger, happiness, and confusion is good. The group I am in now there is NO judging. Whether I say something wrong or look for the right word or just say forget it. It is a place to feel sage to be who I am now, that is very different from before my TBI. The people in the group don't have any expectations of us, they are just happy that we are there.

This is what I want to bring to the Mora area. There are many people that have TBI here from accidents, falls, surgery, attacks and strokes, and I want you to know you are not alone. The people that help us recover and live with our TBI are invited to come also. There are things that they see, hear and live with that is not normal for people without a TBI. The group is a place for you to have a time to just be you whatever day it is today.


