When?

1st Tuesday every month from 6:00 P.M. – 7:30 P.M. – Starting May 6th

Why?

My name is Becky Ponto and I have a traumatic brain injury (TBI). It is very hard to understand the life we have from a TBI. We need to find a new life we will live with the TBI. Talking to other people that have a TBI and understand what it is like to have frustration, anger, happiness, and confusion is good. The group ${\sf I}$ am in now there is NO judging. Whether I say something wrong or look for the right word or just say forget it. It is a place to feel sage to be who I am now, that is very different from before my TBI. The people in the group don't have any expectations of us, they are just happy that we are there.

This is what I want to bring to the Mora area. There are many people that have TBI here from accidents, falls, surgery, attacks and strokes, and I want you to know you are not alone. The people that help us recover and live with our TBI are invited to come also. There are things that they see, hear and live with that is not normal for people without a TBI. The group is a place for you to have a time to just be you whatever day it is today.
