
# Non-Fiction

<u>A Window into the Attic</u> by Paul Kilmore. We have put this book into Section 9 (Social Issues) in the library. It is also part autobiography and part history. The author moved with his family to Mora, Minnesota when he was 11 years old and graduated from Mora High School in 1976. He is now a lawyer in Duluth and is also a writer. In the <u>A Window into the Attic</u>, the author weaves his own experiences of his formative years in Mora with the historical accounts of early settlers of Mora and Kanabec County. This is an interesting book for both long-time Mora residents and those who came later to learn a little history of the area.

#### **Fiction**

Our library has quite a few novels with an Amish theme. The series of books by Cindy Woodsmall known as the Ada House Novels are some of those. In *The Hope of Refuge*, a young widow & her daughter leave New York for an Amish community in Pennsylvania looking for answers to the mystery of her past and for a fresh start. An Amish man, Ephraim Mast, befriends her which is threatening his way of life. Ephraim's sister, Deborah's fiancé Mahon Stoltzfus begins acting strangely. What secrets lie beneath the surface in this Amish community? In *The Bridge of Peace*, a young teacher, Old Order Amish woman, Lena Kauffman, is challenged by a rebellious student and is dealing with crises at the school which threatens other students. Some of Lena's ideas do not follow Old World ways which causes the School Board to blame her for the problems including an old friend of Lena's, School Board member, Grey Graber who has his own secrets. In *The Harvest of Grace*, Sylvia Fisher has been forced to move far from her home to escape a dangerous connection with an old beau. She begins to work at reviving the debt-ridden farm of Dora and Michael Blanks who treated her like a daughter. Then Dora & Michael's son Aaron returnes home after spending time in rehab. Aaron had planned to move his parents from the farm to start a new life, but having Sylvia there ruined his plans. Can Aaron and Sylvia find common ground?




